

This project surveys our MC Canada pastors from 1975 to 2008

The survey set out to understand how Mennonite Church Canada can best nurture and support its pastors.

B. We have also made adjustments to the position of Denominational Minister and added to it the title: Director of Leadership Development

Sven Eriksson's retirement last March gave us an opportunity to examine what new needs have arisen and how this office can respond as we go forward. Such reviews are a routine part of every staff transition.

When Karen Martens Zimmerly begins her work this September, she will be Denominational Minister, but also Director of Leadership Development.

We have maintained the traditional role of minister to the denomination, but we have spelled out more clearly the role of this position in strengthening the leadership development capacity of our church

Karen will be charged with:

Promoting a vision and strategy for pastoral and other leadership development in MC Canada

Nurturing a culture of call for pastoral and other leaders within MC Canada, in partnership with Area Churches

Promoting the training and ongoing formation of ministers and candidates for ministry, with area churches, church schools, agencies and staff

Paying attention to emerging leadership issues in MC Canada, including attention to alternative leadership models

2. We also want to talk to you about a new Mennonite Church Canada Leadership training fund:

This new Leadership Training Fund will be specifically focused on support and training for pastoral leaders;

You as a church have called for the strengthening of our pastoral leadership development capacity;

You have been clear in communicating that you want to be able to direct your giving in ways that will ensure that our pastors can get the formal training they need, within our Anabaptist Mennonite tradition. We want to take you seriously.

We have now established the beginnings of an MC Canada "Leadership Training Fund." We envision that this fund will target pastoral leadership candidates—by offering financial assistance to individuals who declare their intent to prepare for pastoral leadership ministry.

Some of you may be familiar with the longstanding Company of 1000 forgivable loan fund. This fund will continue and will become one aspect of a more broadly based Leadership Training Fund.

We also envision that money given to the Leadership Training Fund will be multiplied with matching support by congregations, area churches and our schools. Details of this fund are still being shaped. But we do expect that the Leadership Training Fund will grow to offer a variety of different ways to participate financially in the church's mission of growing leaders. In terms of accounting, for the present time this fund will continue to appear under the General Board budget.

You can help make this dream come true and insure that our church will be guided by strong pastoral leaders for many years to come.

We invite and challenge you to put your money where your heart and our vision for pastoral training lies.





Ministry with Seniors

- 1/3 of Canadians turning 65
- 11,000 in Mennonite Church Canada
- Challenge and opportunity

3. Ministry with Seniors

In the next 15 years close to 1/3 of Canadians will turn 65 years of age (Including Sue & Dave!)

In MC Canada terms this represents about 11,000 of those currently listed as members of our congregations, not counting those affiliated but not formally members, or the many more linked to networks of friendship

This growing bulge of seniors represents a huge challenge and opportunity for the church





Challenge?

What is the Challenge? to offer resources that will help with the spiritual needs of this generation

-- as they experience transitions from relative health to increasing issues with health; as they try to juggle giving "sandwich care" to their parents and at same time to their grown and growing offspring; as they look to the church to help them make meaningful connections between their experience and their quest for spiritual depth.
